idea will have a stronger sense of power for the listening, in other words the authenticity of the idea has a high value among factors that can determine the strength of the song. The types of melodies used in ECE songs can use the up and down tone graphs contained in the song, such as stepping melody or jumping melody. The types of keystrokes often used are notes with a single tap, two taps and three taps, as children's songs are generally cheerful, while the type of note that four beats are rarely used [15]. Lyrics/Song text. The text or lyrics of the song in ECE children are TFP (term, fact, principle) for children, so that every word and sentence they sing to be knowledge for the child. In each "song" is more focused to the social relationships of saying friends, gratitude, hard work, and others. So in addition to being a TFP, songs can also build children's characters/attitudes. The text of the song depicts the nature and way of thinking children. It is based on the way of thinking children who are innocent, clear, straightforward, exploiting, familiarity, and full of spontaneity. The use of simple language in accordance with the level of children's language proficiency, which is the Indonesian language that is often used in children's environment or in educational institutions [15].

5. IMPLEMENTATION OF MOTION LEARNING AND SONGS IN EARLY CHILDHOOD

Some of the activities performed on motion and song Learning are:

5.1 Motion learning Planning and song

Planning is the basic process used to select objectives and determine the scope of achievement [16]. According to Sanjaya (2008) Learning planning has several functions including creative function, innovative functions, selective function, communicative function, predictive function, accuracy function and goal achievement function. To make good and ideal learning planning, every teacher should know the

elements of learning planning. Elements of motion learning planning and songs according to Bowo (2015) consist of setting learning objectives [17], determination of learning materials, assigning learning methods and techniques and establishing the evaluation of learning

5.2. Implementation of motion learning and song

The implementation of learning is the core activity of the entire learning process. In this section, the teacher plays a role to carry out the planned meaning of delivering messages, materials, and other important information that must be received by students [17].
