All of the articles in this proceedings volume have been presented at the *Meaning in Life International Conference 2022* during *June 22–25, 2022* in Hong Kong, China. These articles have been peer reviewed by the members of the MIL 2022 International Conference International Programme Committee and approved by the Editor-in-Chief, who affirms that this document is a truthful description of the conference's review process.

1 Review Procedure

The reviews were *double-blind*. Each submission was examined by *at least 2* reviewer(s) independently.

The conference submission management system was Easychair.

The submissions were first screened for generic quality and suitableness by the editors. After the initial screening, they were sent for peer review by matching each paper's topic with the reviewers' expertise, taking into account any competing interests. Reviewers review the manuscript according to the guidelines provided and verify the quality of research. A paper could only be considered for acceptance if it had received favourable recommendations from two reviewers.

Authors of an accepted submission were given the opportunity to revise and resubmit after addressing the reviewers' comments. The acceptance of a revised manuscript was final.

2 Quality Criteria

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions:

- 1. Pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;
- 2. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
- 3. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
- 4. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
- 5. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher.
