These articles have been peer reviewed by the members of the Scientific Committee ICLEH 2022 and approved by the Editor-in-Chief, who affirms that this document is a truthful description of the conference’s review process.

1 Review Procedure

The reviews were single-blind, Each submission was examined by 1 reviewer(s) independently.

Manuscripts sent by the author will go through a review process by the editor, especially checking the suitability of the manuscript with the scope and Proceeding template. In this process, the editor will establish communication with the author so that the manuscript deserves to be sent to the Reviewer or even returned/declined. Manuscripts that have passed step 1 above, will be sent to reviewers for content review using the blind review method. The review process will consider novelty, objectivity, methods, scientific impact, conclusions, and references. Reviewers will suggest improvements and accept/reject articles. The editor will decide by considering suggestions from reviewers whether the manuscript meets the requirements to be included in the court proceedings or not. The decision of the editor in chief is final.

Authors of a rejected submission were given the opportunity to revise and resubmit after addressing the reviewers’ comments. The acceptance or rejection of a revised manuscript was final.

2 Quality Criteria

In the review process, you must follow the criteria requirements that have been set by the organizers of ICLEH 2022, as for the criteria that need to be considered in the process of reviewing articles, they must meet the following criteria;

1. Pertinence of the article’s content to the scope and themes of the conference;

2. Ensure the suitability and guarantee the quality of the manuscript in parts, abstracts, keywords, background, research methods, discussion and analysis, conclusions, and writing systematics
3. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
4. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
5. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
6. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables;
7. The reviewer must free himself from conflicts of interest against the article under review.

In addition to the provisions that have been required in the review process, all articles must also go through checking the level of similarity to avoid overlapping the published articles.
