



# Developments and cutting-edge themes in the field of education research since the handover of Macau -- CNKI-based bibliometric analysis

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**Abstract.** The aim of this study is to provide a comprehensive understanding of education research in Macao since its return to China and offer guidance and foundations for the development and improvement of education in Macao. Utilizing the CNKI database, a literature analysis was conducted to gain a comprehensive understanding of the development trends and cutting-edge themes in education research in Macao. The findings reveal that the research hotspots in Macao education since its return primarily focus on higher education collaboration within the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area, education policies and the development of the special administrative region, youth education and social impact, as well as education assessment and quality assurance. Moreover, research in Macao education since its return demonstrates interdisciplinary collaboration, international cooperation, an increased importance on policy research, and a growing emphasis on early childhood education and early development. Recommendations for enhancing teacher quality, promoting curriculum reforms, fostering internationalization in education, and optimizing the allocation of educational resources are proposed to stimulate innovation and ensure the sustainable development of education in Macao.

## 1 Introduction

Education is an important field that governments worldwide universally prioritize due to its crucial role in societal progress, prosperity, and sustainable national development. Since the return of Macau in 1999, the education sector has undergone rapid

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development and transformation. The Macau SAR government places a high emphasis on education, considering it a vital pillar of social development. It actively allocates resources, increases investment and support in education, and strives to enhance educational quality and promote students' holistic development. The government has formulated and implemented a series of education policies and plans, including teaching management, resource allocation, teaching reforms, and teacher training. Additionally, it emphasizes the coordinated development of preschool education, basic education, vocational education, and higher education to provide diverse educational opportunities and high-quality educational services.

Simultaneously, the central government highly values the education sector in Macau and provides strong support through policy guidance, economic assistance, and talent cultivation. It provides relevant funding and resources to promote cooperation and exchange between Macau's education system and mainland China as well as international educational institutions. Through various exchange programs and training initiatives, it fosters the growth and improvement of educational professionals in Macau. The attention and support from both the central government and the Macau government create a favorable environment and conditions for the development of education in Macau. However, Macau's education still faces challenges and shortcomings, including uneven distribution of educational resources, insufficient development momentum in higher education, limited coverage of teacher training and development, inadequate utilization of educational technology, and prominent student pressures and mental health issues. To further enhance the quality and competitiveness of education in Macau, continuous efforts are needed to strengthen resource allocation, elevate teacher professionalism, promote educational innovation and technological applications, and prioritize students' holistic development and well-being, thereby contributing to a more prosperous and sustainable future for Macau's education.

This study aims to provide a comprehensive understanding and grasp of education research in Macau since its return to academia and educational management. Through in-depth analysis of development trends and cutting-edge topics, it seeks to promote innovation and progress in education research in Macau, facilitate the formulation and improvement of educational policies, and provide scientific evidence and guidance for educational development and quality enhancement.

## **2 Review of the literature**

### **2.1 Background and characteristics of education in Macau since the handover**

Since its return, the Macau Special Administrative Region (SAR) government has attached great importance to educational development and is committed to building a modern, diversified, and internationalized education system (Table 1). In terms of education policies, the government has formulated a series of regulations and policies to promote reform and innovation in the education system. The allocation of educational resources has been optimized, with emphasis placed on the training and enhancement of the teaching workforce. Continuous improvements have been made in the construction of educational facilities, and the application of information technolo-

gy in education is increasingly widespread. Moreover, the Macau SAR government actively promotes education internationalization by engaging in cooperative exchanges with international educational institutions, drawing on advanced educational concepts and experiences to enhance Macau's international competitiveness in education.

The research aspects related to education in Macau have also become more diversified. First, scholars have focused on policy making and institutional changes in Macau education, exploring topics such as education quality, market-oriented reforms, centralization and localization[1-5] . Second, scholars have also studied the role, teaching practices, and professional development of teachers in Macau education, focusing on teacher identity transformation, the use of technology in assessment, and strategies for working with parents in integrated education, providing empirical research and experience sharing to improve teacher quality and promote student learning.[6-9] . In addition, there are also studies that focus on the impact of social and civic education, English-medium instruction, and language planning on language development and cultural identity in Macau, which provide useful suggestions for developing multilingual policies and language teaching strategies that can help develop students' language proficiency and cross-cultural communication skills[10-11] . There are also scholars in the field of education research who have explored the challenges and directions of development of education in Macau from different perspectives and topics, which provide references for in-depth research on.

## 2.2 History of the development of the education sector in Macau since the handover

**Early Stage of Return (1999-2004):** In the initial stage of Macau's return to China, the education system faced the significant task of reconstruction and development. The main objectives during this stage were to restore educational infrastructure, improve educational quality, and promote universal basic education. The Macau government invested substantial resources in rebuilding school facilities, enhancing educational conditions, and strengthening teacher training to improve the professionalism of educators. At the same time, educational curricula were adjusted and reformed to adapt to Macau's unique culture and social needs.

**Development Stage (2005-2014):** During this stage, Macau's education experienced rapid growth and reform. The government made significant investments in the education sector, promoting systemic reform and innovation to improve educational quality and international competitiveness. Higher education and vocational education became key areas of development, with the introduction of advanced international educational concepts and resources to enhance the internationalization of education. Additionally, Macau actively promoted the development of early childhood educa-

tion, providing more early educational opportunities to ensure children receive a solid educational foundation before entering school.

**Transformation and Upgrading Stage (2015-present):** Macau's education has entered a phase of transformation and upgrading, focusing on nurturing talent with innovation and practical abilities. The goal during this stage is to cultivate high-quality talents that meet the needs of social development, with an emphasis on enhancing students' innovative thinking and practical application abilities. The education system places importance on the development of science and technology education, innovative education, and information technology education to foster students' scientific literacy and creativity. Furthermore, Macau has strengthened cooperation and exchanges with international educational institutions, promoting the internationalization of education and providing students with broader international perspectives and opportunities.

### **3 Sources and Methods**

#### **3.1 Sources of information**

The research data was obtained from the Chinese National Knowledge Infrastructure (CNKI) Academic Journal Full-text Database. The search was conducted using the following criteria: subject terms "Macau AND education," with the search scope limited to journals. The time span for the search was set from December 20, 1999, to June 7, 2023. A total of 1,478 relevant literature articles in the field of Macau education were obtained.

#### **3.2 Research Methodology**

Based on bibliometric analysis, this study employed software tools such as VOSviewer to systematically analyze the distribution of research hotspots and the evolution of research trends in Macau education. Visualization maps were generated to depict the findings. VOSviewer is a software tool developed by Professor Ludo Waltman and colleagues from Leiden University, Netherlands, specifically designed for visualizing and analyzing literature. This method provides a direct assessment of research hotspots and related characteristics of the literature.

Use VOSviewer software to analyze the collected data in depth, select "literature coupling" in the analysis type and "keywords" in the analysis module to obtain the corresponding visual graphs and record the specific values of the specific coupling strength; Select "Co-citation" in the analysis type and "Cited literature" in the analysis module to get the co-citation analysis graph and its specific information; select "Co-presence analysis" in the analysis type and "Co-presence analysis" in the analysis module. Select "Co-citation" in the analysis type and "All keywords" in the analysis module to get the network visualization graph of research directions, and continue to select the overlay button to get the trend change graph of research hotspots.

## 4.2 Research Posture

Policy research in education has become a significant focus, examining the implementation, adjustment, and improvement of policies, providing scientific evidence for policy-making, and promoting the optimization and development of the education system. Simultaneously, there is growing attention to early childhood education and early development research, encompassing various aspects of early childhood education policies, educational environments, and children's early development, offering support and guidance for enhancing educational quality and facilitating children's holistic growth. These research directions collective-



projects and the development of teaching resources would continuously elevate their professional standards and the quality of education.

**Advance curriculum reform.** Macau's education needs to adapt to the development needs of modern society. Therefore, promoting curriculum reform is recommended. The focus should be on updating and optimizing subject curricula to enhance students' comprehensive qualities and innovative abilities. Introducing modern educational technologies and teaching methods can cultivate students' information technology skills and self-directed learning abilities. Furthermore, strengthening interdisciplinary education can foster students' integrated thinking and problem-solving skills to meet future societal challenges.

**Promote educational internationalization.** Macau should actively promote educational internationalization. It is advised to establish and expand partnerships with international educational institutions and engage in student and teacher exchange programs. Introducing internationalized educational curricula and advanced teaching concepts can enhance the international influence of Macau's education. Simultaneously, strengthening foreign language education can enhance students' cross-cultural communication abilities and cultivate talents with global competitiveness.

**Optimize the allocation of educational resources.** To enhance the overall quality of education in Macau, optimizing the allocation of educational resources is recommended. Increasing investments in education and improving the efficiency of educational funding utilization are crucial. Expanding the supply of educational resources and improving school facilities and teaching conditions are necessary steps. Furthermore, optimizing school distribution and equitably allocating educational resources can enhance educational equity, ensuring that every student has access to fair educational opportunities and high-quality educational resources.

## 6 Summary

In this study, Advanced Computers and information technologies were extensively applied to conduct the bibliometric analysis. Specifically, automated data scraping tools were employed for the efficient collection of large datasets from the CNKI database. The raw data were then meticulously processed and cleaned using advanced data processing algorithms, ensuring accuracy and reliability. The core of the analysis was carried out through VOSviewer software, which is known for its sophisticated analytical capabilities in network and visual analysis. This software facilitated the generation of highly-interactive visualizations and maps, allowing for an in-depth understanding of the complex relationships and patterns among the key themes and trends in Macau's educational research. Additionally, statistical software was utilized for performing rigorous quantitative analysis, which included trend analysis and correlation studies. The integration of computer and information technologies in this study not only enhanced the efficiency and depth of the analysis but also ensured the empirical robustness of the research, providing valuable insights and recommendations for the education sector in Macau.

The innovation of this study lies in its in-depth exploration and comprehensive analysis of the development trends and cutting-edge topics in the field of education research in Macau since its return. Through comprehensive organization and systematic summarization of relevant literature, this study will reveal the hotspots and trends in Macau's education research, showcasing the interdisciplinary and international collaboration characteristics of educational research, as well as the focus on areas such as education policy, early childhood education, and educational evaluation. Furthermore, this study provides suggestions and recommendations for future cutting-edge topics and research directions in education research in Macau, aiming to contribute to the advancement of education research in Macau and promote the enhancement and progress of the Macau education system.

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
