

# Peer-Review Statements

## 1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were double-blind. Each submission was examined by 2 reviewers independently.

*The conference submission management system was Conference Management Toolkit.*

The submitted papers were peer-reviewed by the external reviewers and an advisory board based on the subject of interest and selected on the basis of originality, clarity, and significance in line with the theme of the conference.

It is guaranteed that a high-quality program will be conducted as the conference will be graced by an unparalleled number of professional speakers from multidisciplinary fields, both from India and abroad.

## 2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Authors Papers will be checked for plagiarism (Turnitin software). If the plagiarism is less than 15 % then only it will be sent to the Reviewers. Reviewers were instructed to check for the conference scope and assess the quality of submissions based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions relevance of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;

1. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
2. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
3. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
4. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher.
