Here are some teachings strategies for using TikTok to engage students' German Speaking Skills:

Prompt-based Speaking Challenges. (1) Select a specific language topic or theme relevant to the students' German proficiency level; (2) Create a TikTok challenge prompt related to the chosen topic, such as asking students to create a 15-second video explaining their favorite German holiday tradition; (3) Introduce the prompt and provide clear instructions for creating the TikTok video; (4) Allocate time for students to brainstorm ideas, plan their videos, and gather any necessary props or materials; (5) Students film and edit their TikTok videos, ensuring they incorporate spoken German to demonstrate their speaking skills; (6) Encourage students to share their TikTok videos with the class or within a designated online group for peer feedback and discussion; (7) Facilitate a class discussion to highlight common themes, language patterns, and areas for improvement in the students' videos; (8) Provide constructive feedback and suggestions for further language practice and improvement.

Collaborative Role-Play Skits.
