1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The article acceptance system is carried out through an international web conference, namely on the <https://icite.upy.ac.id> page. Articles submitted must follow the format (template) provided. The terms of article submission are as follows.

- 1) Articles submitted must be free from elements of plagiarism.
- 2) Articles submitted are works that have never been published in other media.
- 3) Articles submitted are in accordance with the predetermined scope of the conference.

This selection process is carried out by the editor by taking into account the suitability of the scientific field between the article and the editor. So that each article is selected by people who are experts in their fields. This is so that the articles that pass are articles that are really good and of good quality according to their respective scientific fields. Articles that are declared to have passed according to predetermined criteria, are then distributed to reviewers for input and improvement. Reviewers conduct a review process on submitted articles according to their field of expertise. Reviewers only provide suggestions and input to the editor whether the article deserves to be published or not. If it is not feasible then it needs to be revised by the author. The review process is carried out using a single blind review process system. That is a review process carried out where the author does not know who the reviewer has reviewed the article. While the Reviewer knows the name and affiliation of the author. The explanation of the paper acceptance system is presented in Figure 1.



2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Articles submitted must follow the format (template) provided. The terms of article submission are as follows.

- 1) Articles submitted must be free from elements of plagiarism.
- 2) Articles submitted are works that have never been published in other media.
- 3) Articles submitted are in accordance with the predetermined scope of the conference.
