

Peer-Review Statements

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All of the articles in this proceedings volume have been presented at the *International Conference on Management and Business* during *on date October 31st, 2024 in Yogyakarta at Gaia Cosmo Hotel, Indonesia*. These articles have been peer reviewed by the members of the *Scientific Committee* and approved by the Editor-in-Chief, who affirms that this document is a truthful description of the conference's review process.

1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were *double-blind*. Each submission was examined by *at least 2* reviewer(s) independently.

The conference submission management system was Website of International Conference on Management and Business (ICOMB) ustjogja.ac.id and Google Form.

[Submissions were then screened for overall quality and appropriateness. After the initial screening, manuscripts were submitted for peer review, taking into account competing interests and matching the subject matter of each submission with the reviewers' areas of expertise. Only papers that received positive reviews from both reviewers could be accepted. Rejected submissions were given the opportunity to be revised in light of the reviewers' recommendations before being resubmitted. The decision to accept or reject a revised document was final.]

[Articles are reviewed by different affiliates to reduce unconscious bias.]

2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions

1. Pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;

2. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
3. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
4. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
5. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher [*Turnitin and Grammarly*].
