1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were [double-blind]. Each submission was examined by [2] reviewer(s) independently.

Peer Review Process

Each submitted manuscript will receive a unique paper ID. The manuscripts will be initially screened to check for the conference scope and originality. All the submitted manuscripts will be sent for a technical peer review process, and the corresponding author will be notified of the outcome of the review process. ICAIHI 2024 adopts a double-blind review process. Suppose reviewers recommend further improvements in the manuscript. In that case, the manuscript will be sent back to the corresponding author, and the revised version of the manuscript shall be submitted within fifteen days of the date of notification. The final decision on the manuscript will be announced after the third round of evaluation by the technical programme committee.

2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions

1. Pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;
2. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
3. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;

4. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
5. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher.
