All of the articles in this proceedings volume have been presented at the 5th International Conference on Applied Sciences, Mathematics, and Informatics (ICASMI) during 14-15 October 2024 in **Bandar Lampung, Indonesia**. These articles have been peer reviewed by the members of the Technical Committee and approved by the Editor-in-Chief, who affirms that this document is a truthful description of the conference's review process.

1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were double-blind review. Each submission was examined by one member of reviewer(s) independently.

The conference submission management system was Google form and e-mail.

The submissions were first screened for generic quality and suitability. After the initial screening, they were sent for peer review by matching each paper's topic with the reviewers' expertise, taking into account any competing interests. A paper could only be considered for acceptance if it had received favourable recommendations from the two reviewers.

Authors of a rejected submission were given the opportunity to revise and resubmit after addressing the reviewers' comments. The acceptance or rejection of a revised manuscript was final.

2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions

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1. The similarity index of each manuscript submitted is required no more than 25%.
2. The topic must fall within the 5th ICASMI topic, otherwise it will be rejected straight away and all manuscript must be pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;
3. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
4. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
5. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
6. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher. **We strongly recommend author to use Turnitin plagiarism check.**
