



## Peer-Review Statements

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All of the articles in this proceedings volume have been presented at the ISCOMICE 2024 on 23 July 2024 in Menara 165, Jakarta, Indonesia. These articles have been peer reviewed by the members of the Organizing Committee of ISCOMICE 2024, who affirms that this document is a truthful description of the conference's review process.

### 1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were single-blind. Each submission was examined by at least 2 reviewers independently. The submissions were first screened for generic quality and suitability. After the initial screening, they were sent for peer review by matching each paper's topic with the reviewers' expertise. A paper could only be considered for acceptance if it had received favourable recommendations from the two reviewers. All reviewers were instructed to recuse themselves from handling any paper with which they had a conflict of interest.

The submissions were first screened for generic quality and suitability. After the initial screening, they were sent for peer review by matching each paper's topic with the reviewers' expertise, taking into account any competing interests. All papers are accepted but if there are any recommendations from the reviewers, the authors were given the opportunity to revise and resubmit after addressing the reviewers comments.

During the process of writing the papers, all the authors do not receive any assistance from the reviewers. All the paper is fully written by the authors following all the guidance and template provided by the organizers. The reviewers are all from the expert of their major following the topic from ISCOMICE 2024. All the comments and decisions from the reviewers were final.

### 2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions:

- Pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;
- Originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;

- Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
- Adherence to ethical standards relevant to the research field;
- Clarity and coherence in language, including visuals.

1. Pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;
2. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
3. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
4. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
5. Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher.
