All of the articles in this proceedings volume have been presented at the *International Conference on Sustainable Green Tourism Applied Science (ICoSTAS) Engineering Applied Science (EAS) 2025* on 9 – 10 October 2025 in Politeknik Negeri Bali, Kampus Bukit, Jimbaran, South Kuta, Badung Regency, Bali, Indonesia. These articles have been peer-reviewed by the members of the *Indonesian Society of Applied Science* and approved by the Editor-in-Chief, who affirms that this document is a truthful description of the conference's review process.

1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were *double-blind*. Each submission was examined by 2 reviewer(s) independently.

The conference submission management system was Leconfe.

The articles were first screened by iThenticate for the submissions for generic quality and suitability. After the initial screening, they were sent for peer review, matching each paper's topic with the reviewers' expertise, taking into account any competing interests. A paper could only be considered for acceptance if it had received favourable recommendations from the two reviewers.

Authors of a rejected submission were allowed to revise and resubmit after addressing the reviewers' comments. The acceptance or rejection of a revised manuscript was final. The reviewers are recused from the handling of papers by closely related authors, and steps are taken to reduce unconscious bias.

2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions: The pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference; Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research; Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results; Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field; Clarity, cohesion, and accuracy in language and other modes of expression, including figures and tables.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher.
