



Peer-Review and Ethics Statements

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The 2nd International Conference on Economics, Management, Accounting, and Business Digital (ICEMAB 2025), organized by the Faculty of Economics and Business, Universitas Bangka Belitung, is committed to maintaining the highest standards of academic quality and ethical conduct throughout the review and publication process. In alignment with the conference theme, “Islandpreneurship for Sustainable Development: Integrating Blue and Green Economy through Local Innovation and Entrepreneurship,” the conference aims to promote rigorous scholarly exchange and impactful research dissemination.

The following statements outline the principles governing the peer review process and ethical responsibilities of authors, reviewers, and conference organizers.

1. PEER REVIEW PROCESS

- All manuscripts submitted to ICEMAB 2025 undergo a double-blind peer review process, ensuring objectivity, fairness, and academic integrity. The identities of both authors and reviewers are concealed to minimize potential bias and to ensure that evaluations are based solely on academic merit.
- Each paper is reviewed by qualified experts in relevant fields, including economics, business management, project management, Islamic banking, e-commerce, and digital business. Submissions are evaluated based on originality, relevance, methodological soundness, coherence, and alignment with the conference theme.
- Constructive and timely feedback is provided to authors to support academic improvement and enhance the quality of accepted manuscripts.

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2. ETHICAL STANDARDS AND ACADEMIC INTEGRITY

- Authors must submit original and unpublished work. Proper acknowledgment of all cited sources is mandatory. Any form of plagiarism, data fabrication, falsification, or academic misconduct is strictly prohibited and will result in rejection.
- Authors are expected to report research data honestly and transparently. All results and interpretations must reflect the actual findings of the study.
- Ethical principles in research—particularly regarding data collection, analysis, and reporting—must be fully observed.

3. CONFIDENTIALITY OF SUBMISSIONS

- All submitted manuscripts are treated as confidential documents. Reviewers and organizers are obligated to maintain the confidentiality of all materials and must not disclose or discuss any content outside the formal review process.
- Information obtained through peer review must not be used for personal benefit or shared with third parties.

4. CONFLICT OF INTEREST DISCLOSURE

- Reviewers are required to declare any potential conflict of interest and must withdraw from the review process if objectivity cannot be ensured. Conflicts may involve professional, financial, or personal relationships with authors.
- Authors must disclose sources of funding, institutional affiliations, or any other interests that may influence the research outcomes.

5. RESPECTFUL AND CONSTRUCTIVE FEEDBACK

- All communications should reflect academic professionalism and mutual respect. Reviewers must provide feedback in a constructive, objective, and respectful manner.
- The peer review process is intended to support academic development and foster meaningful scholarly dialogue.

6. PUBLICATION ETHICS

- Accepted papers will be published in Atlantis Press at no additional cost. Authors agree to present their papers at the conference and to comply with all publication requirements.
- Simultaneous submission to multiple outlets is considered unethical and will lead to disqualification.
