1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were *double-blind*. Each submission was examined by 2 reviewer(s) independently.

Submissions were first screened for relevance, originality, and suitability to the conference scope. Suitable manuscripts were then sent for peer review by matching the subject of each paper with the expertise of reviewers, while ensuring the absence of conflicts of interest.

A paper was considered for acceptance only after receiving favourable recommendations from the assigned reviewers. Authors were required to address reviewer comments before final acceptance. The final decision regarding acceptance or rejection was taken by the Editor-in-Chief.

2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions

1. Pertinence of the article’s content to the scope and themes of the conference;
2. Clear demonstration of originality, novelty, and timeliness of the research;
3. Soundness of the methods, analyses, and results;
4. Adherence to the ethical standards and codes of conduct relevant to the research field;
