All of the articles in this proceedings volume have been presented at the 10th International Conference on Accounting, Management, and Economics (ICAME X) during 20th-21th November 2025 in Shah Alam, Malaysia. These articles have been peer reviewed by the members of the Scientific Committee and approved by the Editor-in-Chief, who affirms that this document is a truthful description of the conference's review process.

1. REVIEW PROCEDURE

The reviews were double-blind. Each submission was examined by at least 2 reviewer(s) independently.

The submissions were first screened for generic quality and suitability. After the initial screening, they were sent for peer review by matching each paper's topic with the reviewers' expertise, taking into account any competing interests. A paper could only be considered for acceptance if it had received favourable recommendations from the two reviewers. All accepted papers have been revised based on reviewers' comments prior to final acceptance. The acceptance or rejection of a revised manuscript was final.

2. QUALITY CRITERIA

Reviewers were instructed to assess the quality of submissions solely based on the academic merit of their content along the following dimensions: Pertinence of the article's content to the scope and themes of the conference;

1. Originality and novelty of the research;
2. Relevance to the conference themes;
3. Methodological rigor;

- 4. Clarity of presentation;
- 5. Contribution to theory and practice.

In addition, all of the articles have been checked for textual overlap in an effort to detect possible signs of plagiarism by the publisher. This conference adheres to the ethical standards set by Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) and follows the publication guidelines of Atlantis Press.
